The Reds

Boonaburra Shiraz Cabernet 2008/09 £3.00.....£3.80£5.00£14.95

Aromas of vanilla, cherry and ripe plums, this classic Australian red has the flavours of summer berries and just a hint of oak.

Añuela Merlot 2008/09 'Colchagua Valley' £3.15.....£4.15£5.40£15.95

From vineyards situated between the Andes and the Pacific this handpicked Merlot has the aromas of plum and fresh mulberries. It is soft and elegant with the flavours of berry fruits and just a hint of vanilla from its time in barrel.

Valpolicella V.....£16.50

Has won the wine region wine of 2009, need we say more.

Da Vinci Chianti Classico 2007.....£22.50

From steep vineyards situated between Florence and Siena the classic Chianti is made under the watchful eye of Alberto Antonini. Deep ruby in colour with the fragrance of fresh plum and spicy blackberries, full bodied with soft subtle tannins and ripe fruit flavours, finished with just a hint of cinnamon from the oak ageing, classic sangiovese.

Rioja El Coto 'Crianza' 2006.....£18.50

A quality oak aged wine from northern Spain's best Bodega; it is distinctive with the flavours of ripe red berries and a hint of vanilla coming from spending time in new oak casks.

Cotes du Rhône Villages 'Cairanne' 2005/07.....£19.50

Top village making consistent quality – soft, easy drinking with or without food.

Fleurie 2007/08 Domaine de la Bouronnière.....£21.95

One of the most popular of the ten individual Beaujolais villages, this medium bodied wine has an intense raspberry fruit flavour and delivers excellent quality, try it slightly chilled.

Museum Real Reserva 2003 Cigales.....£25.50

Rich, concentrated ripe berry fruit flavours are your introduction to this stunning new Rioja. Deep cherry in colour, hints of liquorice and spice, this exceptional wine is well balanced and has a long elegant finish,

Barolo 2003/05 'Le Albe'.....£41.95

The top Italian red from Piemonte, known as the king of Italian red wines. Ripe and forward, classic elegant summer fruit scents, spicy ripe tannins and wonderful balance.

The Whites

Boonaburra Chardonnay 2009£3.00 £3.80..... £5.00£14.95

This full flavoured yet soft and elegant Australian white is pale straw in colour with the aroma of peaches and apricots.

Mezzora Pinot Grigio Garganega 2009...£3.10 £4.00..... £5.20£15.50

Produced from grapes grown in the beautiful hills north of Verona, flavours of pears and summer peaches, give a dry, fresh and stylish wine

Caliterra Tributo Sauvignon Blanc.....£3.15 £4.30..... £6.10£17.95

Caliterra Tributo Leyda Sauvignon Blanc 2009 has a very pale yellow colour and greenish highlights on the edge. Soft aromas of green asparagus, lemon and tangerines, complemented with mineral notes feel fantastic on the palate. A perfect ending makes freshness and elegance last for a long time.

Liebfraumilch..... £13.50

or Liebfrau(e)nMilch is a style of semi-sweet white German wine produced in the regions Rheinhessen, Palatinate, Rheingau and Nahe. The name is a German word literally meaning "beloved lady's milk".

Coleridge Hill 2010 'Three Choirs Vineyards'£15.50

Three Choirs is one of England's best known single estates. Producing wines since 1975 this crisp dry white is a great example, in fact the perfect aperitif, it has the aroma's of wild elderflower and nettle with a clean fresh and lasting finish.

Willow Brook 2009/10 'Three Choirs Vineyards'£15.50

From England's foremost and award winning vineyard, this lovely wine has the aromas of delicate rose petals and a surprising mouthful of vibrant citrus fruit flavours giving it good weight and length, English wine making showing what it can do!

Chablis Le Classique 09 P. Bouchard£22.50

A generous wine with excellent mineral characteristics. A classic Chablis showing subtle citrus fruit flavours on the palate and a flinty, mineral finish. Crisp and fresh yet with a bit of weight, this is every inch what a quality Chablis should be.

Sancerre 2008/09 Clos des Bouffants.....£23.95

Dry, fresh and well balanced, this full flavoured attractive wine is a constant favourite - a superb compliment to any dish.

Pouilly Fuissé 2006/07 Pascal Clement£28.50

Coming from the most prestigious and famous vineyard of Macon, hazelnut and grilled almonds on the nose and a creamy peach fruit on the palate, an elegant wine drinking beautifully now.

Champagne & Sparkling

Dom Pérignon £125.00

Dom Pérignon was the 17th century Benedictine monk who has gone down in history as the person who invented Champagne. His name was originally registered by Eugène Mercier. He sold the brand name to Moët & Chandon, who used it as the name for its prestige cuvée, which was first released in 1937. Each vintage offers thus a new aspect of Dom Pérignon, reflecting an assemblage that is a unique act of creation for the wine maker Richard Geoffroy. In its constant quest for the ultimate balance between Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, the Dom Pérignon style traces, vintage after vintage, a complex structure made up of aroma and sensations, silky smooth, light as air and full of sensuality.

Taittinger Brut Reserve NV £41.95

A careful blend of 25 different 'Crus' and ageing of between 3 and 4 years go into making this delicate and elegant Champagne.

Louis Perdrier Brut (Sparkling) £16.50
